### **Anticipated Special Education Teacher for the 2023-2024 school year:**

The Maine Academy of Natural Sciences (MeANS) has an anticipated opening for a Special Education Teacher in Math. The successful candidate will be responsible for direct instruction to students, working as an advisor to a small group of students, working as a collaborative member of a team centered approach to student planning, and all required special education and school related processes.

This position will follow the MeANS academic calendar which is based on a year round schedule with a typical 4-day school week. The successful candidate will work 183 academic days. The successful candidate will hold or be eligible for Maine State Certification in special education. Preference will be given to candidates with experience in special education at the high school level, knowledge of special education processes, a passion for working with at-risk students, and demonstrated ability to work as a member of a team.

Must hold or be eligible for Maine State Certification (282) in special education. Background and health check required as well as a valid driver's license and solid professional and personal references and a genuine commitment to child welfare.
